

Great News, CAMP IS ON!! We missed seeing you last summer! We <u>are</u> having C3 Camp this summer at Cragmont!! We are excited about offering an awesome week of worship, recreation, and FUN on the mountain. Please understand that camp will look different this year and we wanted to share some important details. Cragmont has set guidelines and policies that we, C3 Camp, must follow. For that reason, there are several key aspects of camp that will look different and I'd like to address them for you.

CAMPER LIMITS AND CAMP LIFE:

- Cragmont decided to limited camp to 100 campers and 25 staff.
- For that reason, C3 Camp will be offered for kids who are currently in 5th grade 12th grade.
 - ♦ We will not be offering an elementary version of Camp this year.
 - ♦ This is disappointing to us however, based on Cragmont camper limitations, we felt that this was one of the best ways to help limit the amount of campers.
- Campers will be placed in cohorts of no more than 10 campers and 1 counselor.
 - ♦ Most camp activities and happenings will occur in these individual cohorts.
 - ♦ However, there will be some opportunities for free time.
 - Whether in the cohort or in free time, campers will be expected to wear a face mask and practice social distancing (except in the dorms) at all times.

CAMP DATES AND LENGTH:

- Cragmont decided to limit camp to 4 nights with 2 options for start days.
 - ♦ Option 1 Monday Friday Camp Week
 - ◊ Option 2 Tuesday Saturday Camp Week
 - ♦ C3 will operate on a Tuesday Saturday Camp Week.
- The dates for camp are Tuesday June 15th- Saturday June 19th.

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- The cost of camp will be \$300 per camper.
- This is a reduction from \$400 in previous years.
 - ♦ This reduction is based on transportation expense normally incurred by C3.
 - ♦ It is also based on reduced lodging fees for a 4-night stay verses a 5-night stay.



TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM CAMP:

- Cragmont decided not to allow the individual weeks of camp to organize transportation of campers, to and from Cragmont, on Charter Buses.
- For this reason, parents will be responsible for getting their kids to and from camp. Here are some options for Parents.
 - ♦ Parents can personally drive their kids to and from Cragmont.
 - ♦ Parents can work with another family to carpool their kids to and from Cragmont.
 - Parents can work through their local church, using Church transportation (Vans/ Church Buses), to transport their kids to and from Cragmont.
- Regardless of the transportation option you choose, C3 Camp will follow the following
 policies and procedures, established by Cragmont, upon arrival of any and all vehicles at
 Cragmont.
 - Bring your completed Pre-camp Health Screening Form and, if not submitted previously, your Covid-19 Waiver Form. Both forms are required for participation in Cragmont Summer Camp 2021.
 - ♦ Remain in your vehicle until your child(ren) is/are checked in this will include a camper health screening.
 - Once checked-in, campers will proceed directly to their designated lodging for the week.
 - ♦ Parents will only be allowed in the drop-off area of camp.
- Additional considerations concerning Cragmont's "upon arrival" policy and procedure.
 - If anyone in a vehicle (including single child homes, large families, and group transportation) shows up to camp, and during the health screening shows any symptoms of Covid or other illnesses, they will not be permitted to participate in camp.
 - ♦ If a camp counselor happens to be in that vehicle, they too will not be able to stay at camp.



REGISTRATION POLICY FOR C3 CAMP:

- Registration will begin on April 1st for all campers who attended C3 camp in 2019, with a priority deadline of April 14th.
 - ♦ Current Juniors and Seniors are guaranteed a spot (Deadline 4/14)
 - ♦ Current 5th 10th graders may or may not be accepted based on the following factors/limitations (Deadline 4/14).
 - ♦ Attended camp in 2019
 - ♦ Gender / Age
 - Church percentage (each participating church from 2019 will receive a percentage or number of spaces)
 - ♦ Spots are limited to a total of 100 campers.
- If C3 Camp has additional space remaining, after the priority round of registration, then registration will open on April 15th for anyone based on these factors:
 - ♦ Currently 5th-12th grade (With priority still going to 11th and 12th graders)
 - ♦ Gender / Age
 - ♦ Campers from churches who participated @ C3 Camp in 2019.
